


- 1 Refine a search without navigating away from the results page

Download eBooks

to a computer:

1. Install the Adobe Digital Editions in your computer (available as a freeware application).
2. Authorize your device via AdobeID.
3. Click on the button „Download (Offline).
4. Sign in to your My EBSCOhost account (available for free).
5. Select the checkout duration and download a file into your device via Adobe Digital Editions.

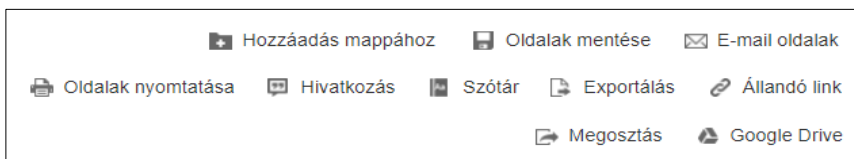
to a mobile device:

1. Install Blue Fire app on your mobile device (available for free at Google Play or iTunes).
2. Authorize your device via AdobeID.
3. Find an eBook via internet browser
4. Sign in to your My EBSCOhost account (available for free).
5. Select the checkout duration and download a file into your device.

Display eBooks online

Viewing eBooks directly in a web-based interface — no reader or hardware required.

To **print/email/save pages** from the eBook, **retrieve citations** or **share its content via Google Drive** use enhanced user tools.
